### CODE OF CONDUCT 2010

This form must be signed on both sides by both camper and parent or guardian, as part of our efforts to create a safe and enjoyable camping experience for all children attending Camp Miriam.

The following behaviour is expected and required of all campers while attending camp:

1. All campers must respect and abide by the authority and guidance of counsellors and staff.
2. All campers are required to participate in all aspects of the camp programs.
3. All campers are expected to treat fellow campers & staff with respect and consideration. Swearing, violent and /or abusive behaviour is not allowed.
4. Drugs, alcohol and smoking are absolutely forbidden at camp. Campers will be immediately sent home if caught violating this rule, without exception.
5. All campers are expected to respect camp facilities as well as the personal property of other campers and staff members. Any costs resulting from damages caused by the camper will be the responsibility of the camper's parents, and they will be billed accordingly.

Any camper who does not respect and abide by this code of conduct will be sent home at the discretion of the camp management. If a camper is sent home, camp fees will not be refunded. The parent/guardian is responsible for any extraordinary costs of sending the camper home.

## CAMP MIRIAM BEHAVIOUR PROTOCOL

Camp Miriam, as a member of Habonim Dror Youth Movement, provides a unique camping experience in which members of the camp community explore Jewish life and culture through a variety of activities.

Camp Miriam embraces the movement ideology that encourages the struggle against apathy and social injustice, challenges the status quo on environmental issues, and promotes the concept of personal responsibility in community development.

In order to provide a safe and positive environment, all members of the Camp Miriam community are expected to treat others with respect and to conduct themselves as a *dugma* (example) for others to follow. This includes respecting the property of others, not having any involvement with illegal substances and resolving conflict in a non-violent and responsible manner.

Camp Miriam will consider the behavior of any member of the camp community that adversely affects the camp community to be a serious breach of the camp's code of conduct and will warrant intervention.
